Jason has served as the Deputy Chief of the Office of Investigations & Analysis (CG-INV) at Coast Guard Headquarters since June 2023. His office is responsible for overseeing marine casualty investigations, suspension and revocation cases involving credentialed mariners, violation investigations and data analysis for the Coast Guard's Prevention operations. Jason retired from active-duty Coast Guard service in 2023 after a 31-year career that included eight years as the CG-INV Office Chief. Since 2015, Jason has served as the Chair of three Coast Guard Marine Boards of Investigation, including the sinking of the S.S. EL FARO during Hurricane Joaquin, the fire aboard the small passenger vessel CONCEPTION, and the implosion of the submersible TITAN during a deep-sea expedition to the RMS TITANIC.
